"The Safety Confirmation System" of the University of Tsukuba has been changed to "ANPIC", the safety confirmation system from November 1, 2020. This makes it possible to aggregate the safety information of students, faculty members, and employees in real time in the event of a disaster and use it for prompt disaster response.

Students, faculty members, and employees should make [initial registration for ANPIC](#) in case of an unpredictable large-scale disaster, and make sure that they can report their safety.

Report your safety from The Smartphone App

Two Ways to Report Your Safety !



Report from "The safety confirmation e-mail" that arrives at the registered e-mail address (or app)



Login to the ANPIC site (<https://anpic-v-t.jecc.jp/u-tsukuba/>) and report your safety
